### *Changes to the Rehab/CCC Care Type*

The RM&R program will be aligning the Rehab/CCC pathway forms with the Rehab/CCC Provincial Referral Standards and GTA Rehab Network Inpatient Rehab/CCC forms, which is anticipated to start in Fall 2015. This work is expected to involve a **new Rehab/CCC care type within RM&R** and retire the old Rehab/CCC referral care type.

RM&R's Project Team will be engaging sites in the near future. Stay tuned for more information regarding this project!



### *Exciting News – Upcoming Projects in 2015/16*

#### *Community Support Services (CSS) Enhancements Project*

This six month project will engage key stakeholders to understand and prioritize challenges within the current CSS and Community Navigation & Access Program (CNAP) RM&R referral pathways. Once these have been identified, RM&R's Project Team will work towards implementing the supporting application changes.

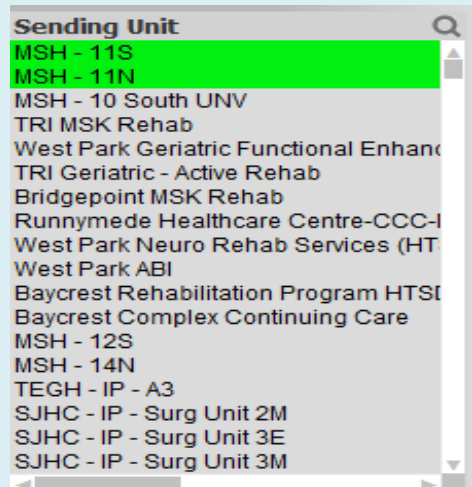
#### *Total Joint Replacement (TJR) Project*

This six month project has been initiated to enable organizations within the TC LHIN to **send** and **receive** TJR outpatient rehabilitation referrals electronically. This implementation will further increase the continuity of care as referral will be going through a centralized referral system.

### Updates to ORBIT

A 'Sending Facility Unit' filter has been added to the Community Care Access Centre (CCAC) pathway, which will allow users to select multiple units at a time and pull the required information for those units under their respective organizations.

To select multiple units, users must hold the 'ctrl' button while making the Unit selections.



### Strata Connect Update

The Strata Connect Project team is planning and preparing for the implementation of Strata Connect; a robust integration engine that will improve the user experience within RM&R by increasing the amount of data that can be automatically populated in RM&R from other health information systems.

This multi-phase project will focus on converting the existing integrated sites over to use Strata Connect. Project kick-off is targeted for October 2015.
