

How do I print prescriptions [LHIN – Home and Community Care]?



What is a prescription report



The **Prescription Report** is used in the RM&R application to print prescriptions from the information entered into the Medical Treatment Order tab for the LHIN – Home and Community Care eReferral care type. For further details on the care type, please see the guide: **'What is a LHIN - Home and Community Form'**

Step 1

Access the existing patient referral by following the **'How do I edit or update a referral?'** guide

Step 2

In the patient's referral, select the **Client Details (2)** tab.

Step 3

Click the **Prescription Report (3)** button.

Step 4

In the resulting **Prescription** window, you can specify the order that the prescriptions appear on the report.

In this example, the patient has 3 medical treatment orders: enteral feeding and flushing, chemotherapy infusion and vascular access device. Each prescription is to be placed on a separate page – you can change the order by selecting the page from the **page number** drop down (4a)

Step 5

You now have several options:

- **Save (5a)** the file as a PDF.
- **View (5b)** the report within your current browser window
- **Print (5c)** the report to a local printer

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Overview

Each page on the prescription report follows the same format:

Patient information and the parameters of the report appear in the header **(6)**

The first box on the report lists the patient details (Name, health card number, date of birth and the patients address) **(7)**

The second box details the prescription. In this example the patient requires an enternal feeding order and flushing **(8)**

The final box provides room for physician sign off. Enter the physician name, contact number, CPSO number and obtain signature **(9)**

Please note: The date the report was generated and by whom is listed at the bottom of each page **(10)**.
