

What is a LHIN - Home and Community referral form?



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LHIN - Home and Community referrals are prepared for patients in an Acute or Rehab setting who are being discharged to their home, and require in-home care. Listed below are all the tabs in the LHIN - Home and Community eReferral form. Please view 'How do I complete a referral?' for more details.

Client Details (1)

Includes a summary of key information about the referral form, such as Patient name, MRN and responsible person(s) for the referral. This is a standard tab across all referral care types.

Demographics (2)

Includes relevant information identifying the patient. This is a standard tab across all referral care types.

Request for Assessment (3)

A quick summary of the client/patient's situation, service area (IP, OP, ED), probable services needed, potential medical orders, and potential discharge date.

Entering information into the **Request for Assessment** tab will trigger the following tabs.

Dietician Report (3a)

A diagnosis, reasons for nutritional intervention and goals for the patient

Nursing Report (3b)

Summary of areas for RN intervention

Occupational Therapy (3c)

An assessment of the patient's functional level & goals

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Physiotherapy Report (3d)

A diagnosis, assessment of patient's functionality and summary of patient history

SLP Report (3e)

Client/patient's diagnosis, functional level and therapy overview

Social Work Report (3f)

A Social Worker's assessment summary, client/patient contacts and recommended services

Medical Treatment Orders (3g)

Summary of medical orders requiring a Physician sign-off. Entering information in this tab will trigger the following sign off tab.

Physician/NP Sign-off (3h)

Medical order sign-off from the Attending Physician, Resident, Nurse Practitioner or Registered Nurse (Extended Class)

Send/Manage Referrals (4)

Includes current referrals associated with the patient and functionalities to send the referral. Please view 'How do I send a LHIN – Home and Community referral?' guide for more details.
