

Deactivate a Referral

Overview

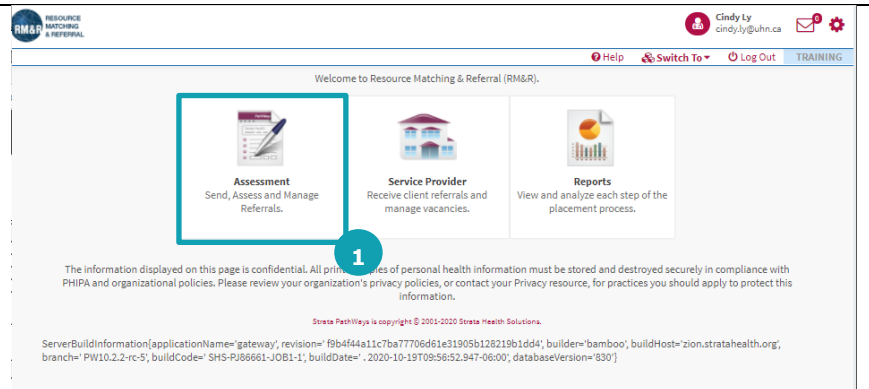
The **Deactivate** functionality in RM&R is used to inactivate the referral and **remove** the referral care type **from all receiving service provider queues**. The Cancel functionality in RM&R is used to **remove** a referral from **one service provider queue** once it's been sent from a care type pathway.

For example, if you wanted to remove the referral from all four receiving service providers, you would select the **deactivate** button; if you wanted to remove the referral from one out of the four receiving service providers, you would select **cancel**.

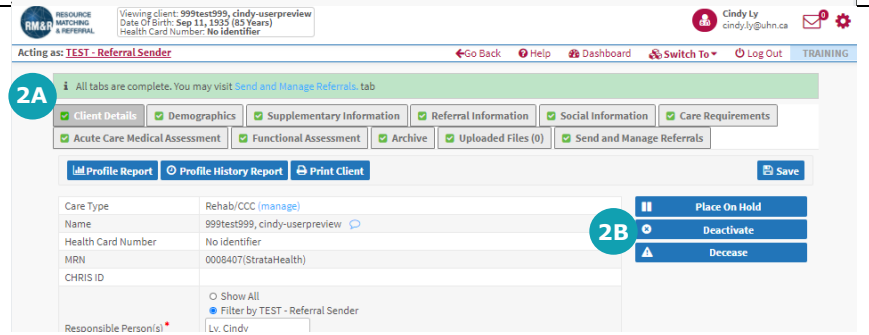
Step 1 Access patient referral

Step 2 Deactivate Referral

- Click on **Client Details** tab
- Click on **Deactivate** button

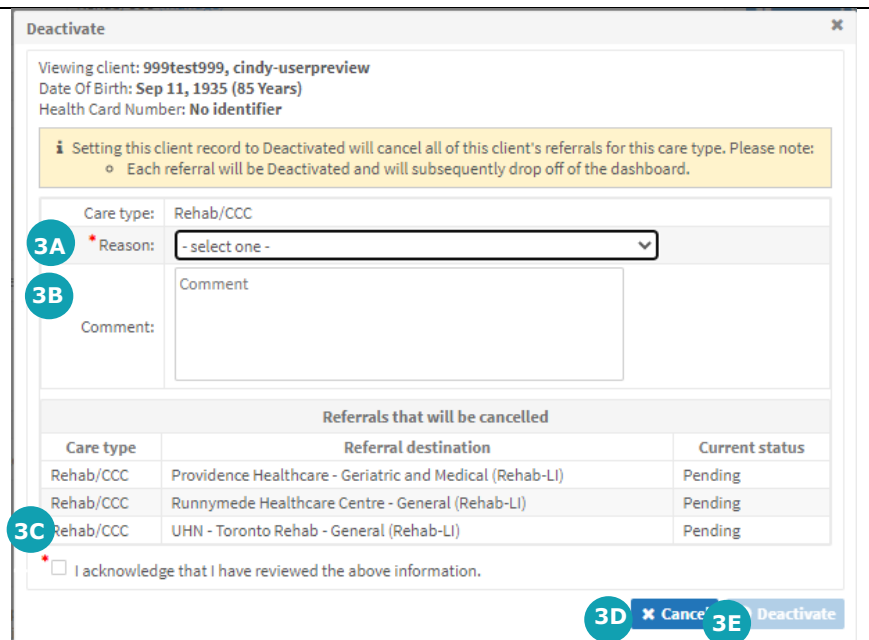


Step 3 Select a reason

In the resulting deactivate pop-up,

- Select a reason for the deactivation
- Enter an optional comment
- Ensure you select the checkbox to acknowledge that you have reviewed the information.

From here, you have 2 options:



1. If you no longer want to deactivate the referral, click the Cancel button (3D)
2. If you want to deactivate, click the Deactivate button (3E)

After clicking Deactivate, you will receive a confirmation banner message and the referral will be removed from all service provider queues.
