

What is an outpatient rehab – total joint replacement (TJR) referral form?



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The Outpatient Rehab – Total Joint Replacement (TJR) referral form in RM&R is used to refer patients in acute settings to Outpatient Rehabilitation services following a knee or hip replacement surgery. Listed below are all the tabs in the TJR referral form. Please view **'How do I complete a referral?'** for more details on completing a referral.

Client Details (1)

A summary of key information about the referral form, such as patient name, MRN and responsible person(s) for the referral. This is a standard tab across all referral care types.

Demographics (2)

Relevant information identifying the patient. This is a standard tab across all referral care types.

Referral Information (3)

Includes a summary of the patient's surgery details, diagnoses and surgeon information.

This tab also indicates whether the referral is being completed pre- or post-operatively; in general, the pre-operative fields on the tab (such as type of surgery, date, anticipated date of discharge), are completed before patient has had TJR surgery, while post-operative fields are triggered categories (such as treatment restrictions, surgeon's agreement for referral) that are to be completed after surgery has taken place.

Send/Manage Referrals (4)

The **Send/Manage Referrals** tab includes current referrals associated with the patient and functionalities to send the referral. Please view **'How do I send a referral [TJR]?'** guide for more details.
